Every year, Globe International holds a mission conference for all Globe missionaries and this year we had the opportunity to attend along with our Haitian Pastor, Andy and our children (Tiffany, M'lin, Daniel, Jessica and Willy). It was so good to see our friends and supporters and meet new missionaries. And while we were there, we took our kids and Pastor Andy to the beach in Pensacola.

After the conference, Cindy and I went to San Francisco to minister to a family who had just adopted a 13 year old girl from Haiti and were having some serious problems. After just one day, we realized that this was not going to be enough. The family allowed us to bring her back to her home country to be counseled and trained and learn how to be loved as a daughter, how to be part of a loving family before going back to her adoptive family. Our calling is to train up orphans into sons and daughters.



Since our return to Haiti. We have been so busy that we haven't been able to sit back and take time to catch up with ourselves. Here is what is going on at the mission.

This month we will have the new land/house in our possession. We have paid half down and we're going to pay the other half on contract. The owner also has a depot (shed) full of cement, steel and other building materials that we might need. He has offered to sell us what we need of those materials on credit in order to finish the house that is already started on the land. Now as much as this sounds good, we have not yet had to borrow to build anything. We have had to borrow occasionally for food, transportation, or payroll during the last thirteen years but we've always built only when we could raise money. I truly prefer not to borrow, so pray with us for wisdom. We feel this is the right decision to get these children into a home where the ceilings are not falling in and they aren't so badly over-crowded.

We now have 50 boys at "In the Father's Hand Children's Home" and with the construction on the new land within the next 2 weeks, we are establishing "In the Father's Arms Girl's Home" with 27 girls. Three adoption dossiers were released out of IBESR this last month, the adoptions are moving. PTL! "Grace Christian School" is about to start summer break and "Grace Chapel" is overflowing for nearly every service.

We thank you for your prayers and supports and remember that we are....
